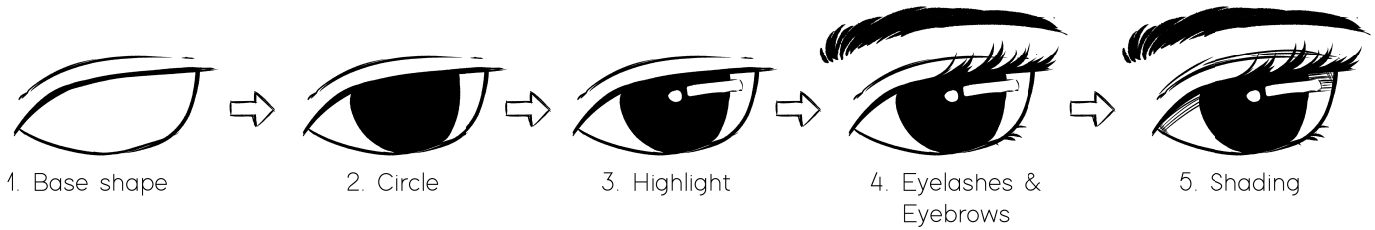

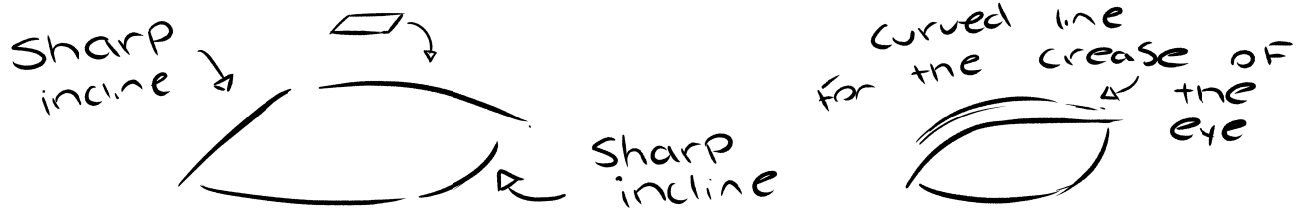

Welcome to this series of worksheets!

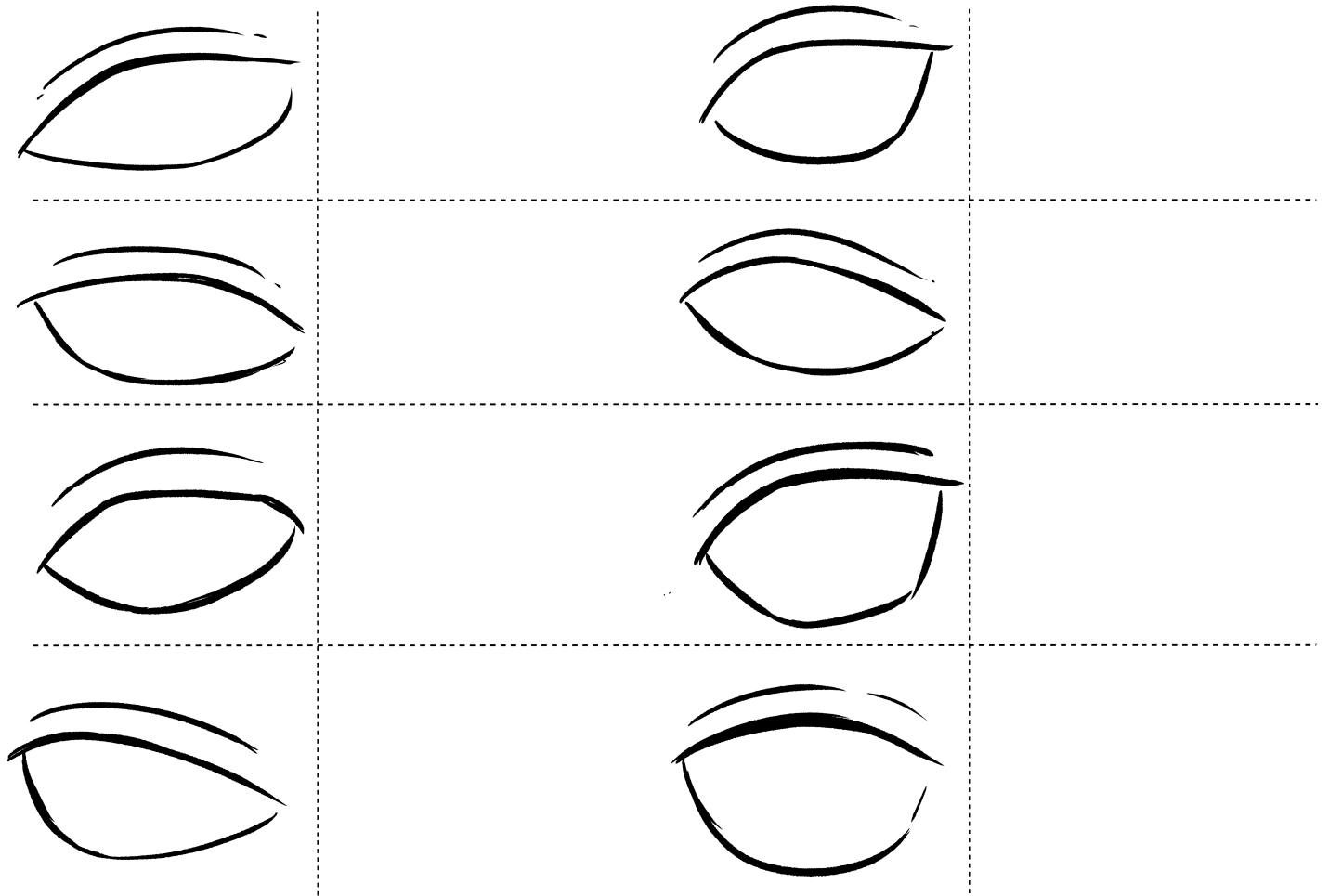
When drawing the eyes there are 5 stages of practice that we will go through to help develop our drawing skills, make sure to take time to get comfortable with each stage before moving forwards!



Base Shape



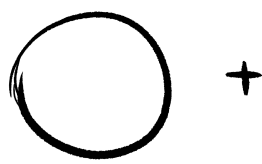

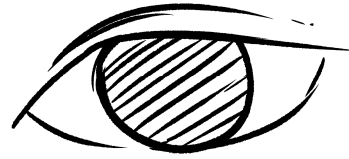
Circle of the Eye

Highlight

Draw in the shape of the highlight before filling in the darks of the eye, you can use a variety of shapes for the highlight.

Eyebrows & Eyelashes

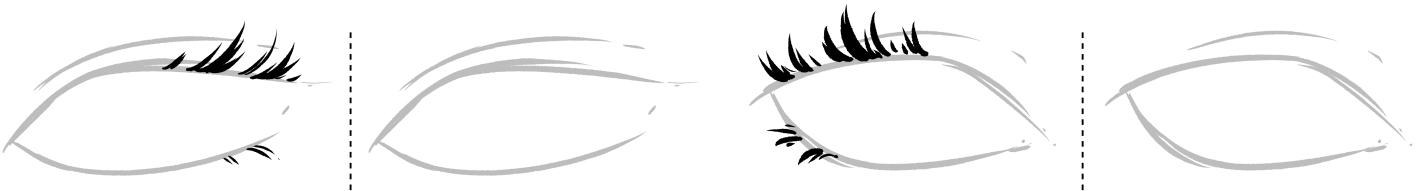


The challenge when drawing eyebrows and eyelashes is getting used to drawing curved lines that feel organic. These curves tend to be more 'curvy' or steep towards the base and more straight towards the ends

Copy the curves across horizontally



When drawing the eyelashes draw one large hair with some gradually smaller hair around it to give it a natural feel. Copy from the examples below.

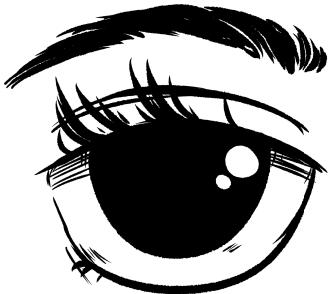
Full Eye
